**“Delicate Arch” is a widely recognized symbol of the state of Utah - seen on license plates, postcards and on pretty much every everything that says Utah!**

The light opening beneath the arch is 46 feet high and 32 feet wide, making it the largest free-standing arch in the park - you can barely see us standing in the middle!

The trail is 3 miles round trip - a fairly steep and steady uphill climb but worth it in every way!
